how to critique a journal article - uis - articles, but each type of article may provoke questions that are especially pertinent to that type and no other. read on. first of all, for any type of journal article your critique should include some basic information: 1. name(s) of the author(s) 2. title of article 3. title of journal, volume number, date, month and page numbers 4.
